

## PADDLE THE NAVESINK DAY

Mark your calendar for the fourth annual “PADDLE THE NAVESINK DAY,” a **free** community-wide celebration of the Navesink River scheduled for Sunday, September 14, 2014, rain or shine. From 11:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., local businesses and organizations along Red Bank’s Navesink River will offer people opportunities to experience kayaking, canoeing, sailing and rowing. At Maple Cove, paddlers can enjoy a mini guided tour of the Navesink River and see Red Bank from another perspective. The Jersey Paddler of Brick will have different types of kayaks and stand-up paddleboards to demo; and all participants will be provided life vests and paddles for use during their on-water sessions. Environmental and maritime groups, including the Navesink Maritime Heritage Association, will provide information on the ecology and history of the river and will host hands-on activities for the kids. The American Littoral Society will host seining activities and a touch tank for adults and children alike.

Adjacent to Maple Cove, Navesink River Rowing will host learn-to-row sessions and will provide information on the programs it offers to adults and to youth.

Three blocks east of Maple Cove on Boat Club Court, the historic Monmouth Boat Club will host an open house. Participants can enjoy free hamburgers and hot dogs, sailboat rides, and information on the club’s adult and youth sailing programs.

Participants can park in the local lots off White Street and Front Street. All municipal parking is free on Sundays.
