

New NRR Policy for Distribution of Rack Space for Privately Owned Boats

Boat storage space at the NRR site is constrained. The Board has established the following policy in order to strike a balance between rack space designated for privately owned boats and rack space reserved for boats owned by NRR and maintained for member usage and training programs.

- Rack space will be made available to **active rowers** who own their own boats and use them regularly.
 - How much usage constitutes regular use is a judgment call but the intent is to avoid having unused boats parked at the site.
- If it should become necessary to limit the number of privately owned boats assigned rack space, then **first priority** will be given to active boat owners in good standing who have stored their boats at the site and used them during the previous season.
- To secure rack space for the upcoming season, these boat owners must indicate their desire for space and register for the upcoming season with application completed, waiver signed and payment made **by April 1**.
- A waiting list will be established for other members who desire a rack space, including those who did not make the April 1 deadline. Priority will be given to previous year members, followed by new members if any.
- If the number of people on the waiting list for rack space exceeds the number of spaces available, a lottery will be held and completed by May 1. To secure a spot won by lottery, season registration and payment must be completed by May 1.
- Any rack space that remains after May 1 will be assigned on a first-come basis.
- A member may store only one single. Multiple seat boat requests (either organization or individual) will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Members are strongly encouraged to check with the Operations Manager before purchasing a boat if they intend to store it at the site.
